

Marriage License

For an official and legal marriage, you must obtain a State of Hawaii marriage license application prior to the ceremony. The application must be finalized in person by an agent of the Department of Health, Marriage License Division.

We recommend that you complete the application and pay for it online as this will expedite the process when you go in to meet an agent who will finalize and issue the marriage license application. The finalized marriage license application is good for 30 days from the date it is issued.

We will use the application to file your marriage online and you will be able to obtain your temporary marriage license in 1-3 business days. Your permanent marriage license will be mailed directly to you by the Department of Health in approximately 1 month.
